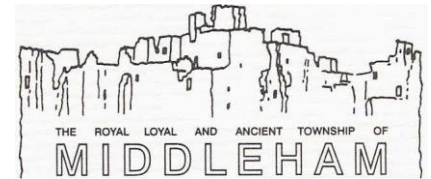

Battle's Over – commemorating 100 years since the end of World War I



Sunday 11th November 2018

Middleham is playing its part in **Battle's Over**, an international commemoration marking 100 years since the guns fell silent at the end of World War I, with events throughout the United Kingdom.

At **7 pm** the beacon on Middleham Castle is being lit, part of a tribute called **Beacons of Light** signifying the light of peace that emerged from the darkness of four years of war.

The bells of St Mary's and St Alkelda's will peel at **7.05pm**, one of over 1,000 church and cathedrals ringing their bells as part of **Ringin' Out for Peace**.

The **Remembrance Sunday church service** is being held at St Mary's and St Alkelda's at **10.50 am**
